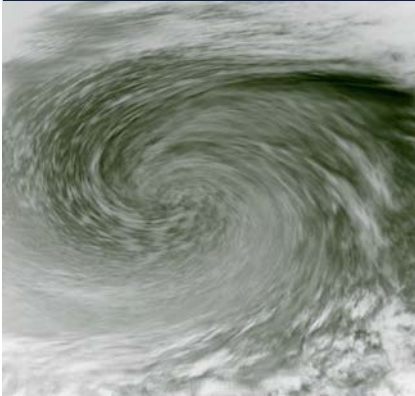


Market Update

Cyclone Evan - Fiji



Cyclone Evan that decimated Samoa on 14 December 2012 has now struck the west coast of Fiji overnight. Winds of up to 270kph that accompanied the Category 4 Cyclone have caused extensive damage.

Evan tracked the west coast of Fiji and has affected an area from Ba to Sigatoka.

Key tourist destinations west of Nadi have sustained substantial damage.

Telecommunications and other infrastructure in Lautoka are affected and detailed information about the nature and extent of the damage is limited but Crawford aims to have more detailed information within 24 hours.

Crawford is liaising closely with insurers in Fiji and has mobilised a team of Australian and New Zealand adjusters.
